Your four days of snowmobiling will take you along the trails of the Laurentian, Lanaudiere and Ottawa regions which are prized by its travelers! With ideal conditions and exceptionally well groomed trails, you will travel up to 200 kilometers of trail per day. You will travel over frozen lakes, zip across vast fields and manoeuvre through fabulous forests. At the end of each day, you will get to relax, dine and sleep in several quaint and cozy resorts.

Here's your itinerary :

Day 1 – Departure from Saint-Hippolyte to Saint-Zenon



Meet at headquarters at 8:00 am to take possession of your snowmobile. Your personal guide will explain everything necessary for the safe operation of your power machine before departing on your ride. You will have time to practice and get to know your machine on our private trails before heading out on the many federally operated trails towards Saint-Zenon. Here you will be greeted by your host Jean-Michel, who awaits you at his little inn with panoramic views, fantastic fondues and lively entertainment around the piano bar. Day 2 – From Saint-Zenon to Nominuingue

Start your day with a healthy breakfast before revving your engines and heading west towards Nominuingue. You will have the chance to cross the Mont Tremblant Park, renowned for its breathtaking countryside and quality of snowmobile trails. Once in Nominuingue, the Auberge Des Demoiselles will welcome you warmly and provides one of the most astounding views of Lake Nominuingue and its surrounding mountains.



Day 3 – From Nominuingue to Duhamel

Be prepared for this full day of snowmobiling by starting off with a hearty breakfast! Today, the adventure continues as you head south to a little town in the Ottawa region called Duhamel. This 4 star resort is renowned for its quality service, the comfort of its rooms and for its fine dining experience. Its wine cellar is award winning and at the end of a long journey, you may find the missing ingredient is a relaxing massage at the spa (\$), a swim in the indoor sea-salt pool or a warm jacuzzi lakeside. Practical Information:

- Quebec has over 33,500 kms of snowmobile trails (groomed and marked) operated by more than a hundred snowmobile clubs.

Weather conditions:

- Winter in Quebec is known to have important accumulations of snow across the Laurentian, Lanaudiere and Ottawa regions much to the pleasure of local snowmobile clubs. Also known for its cold weather, temperatures may drop below 10 celcius, but they may also drop as low as -35 celcius with the wind chill factor. What is known as arctic conditions!

 - Warm clothes (ideally a polar)
 - Change of socks
 - Bathing suit
- You have only a small storage space for personal belongings – pack light!

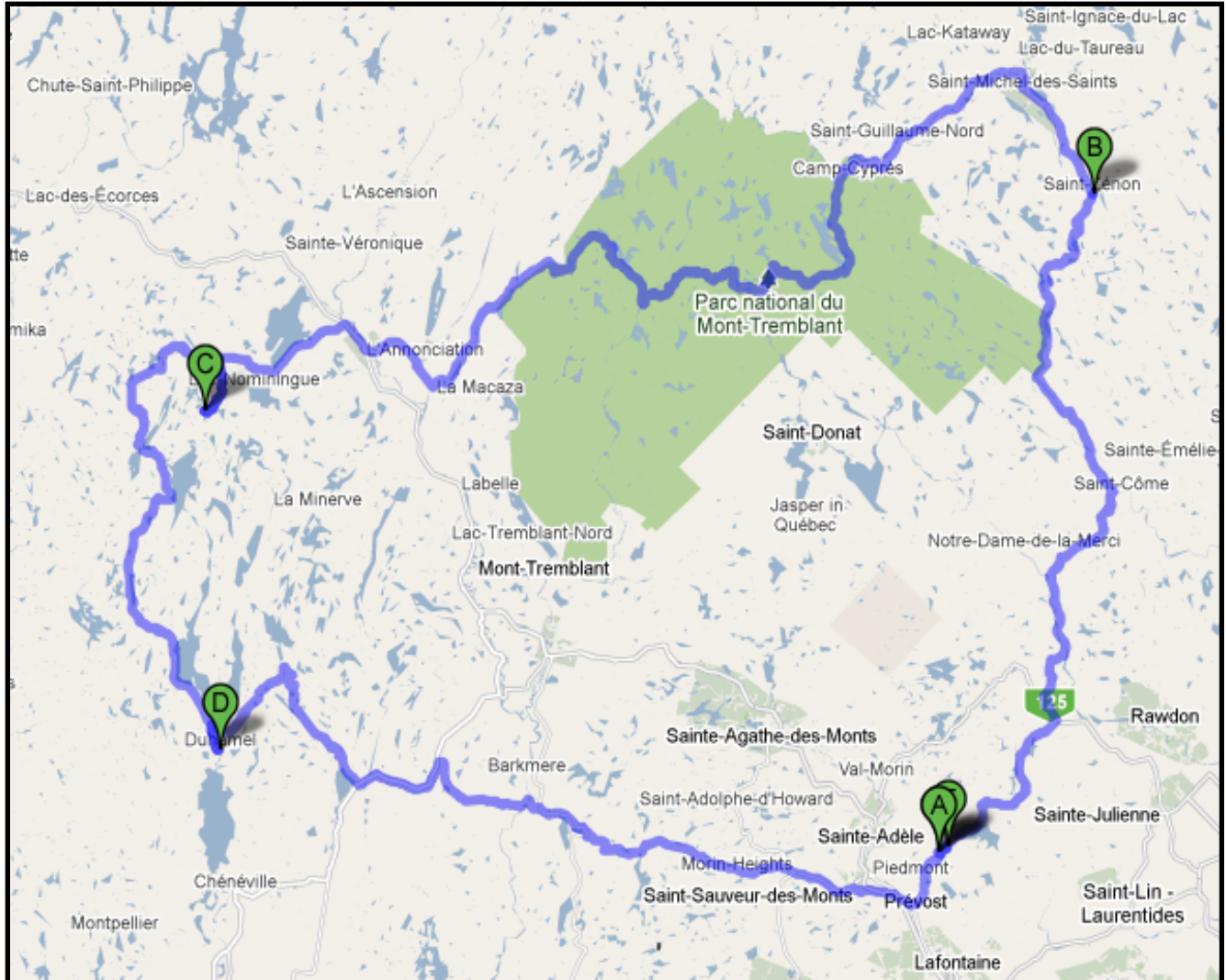
