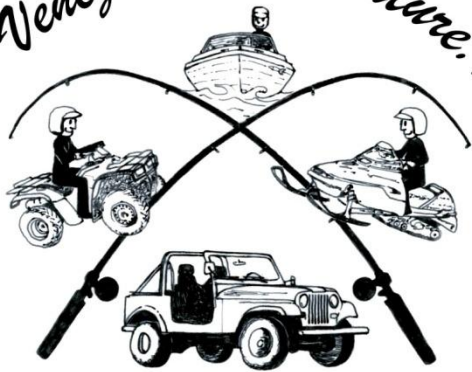

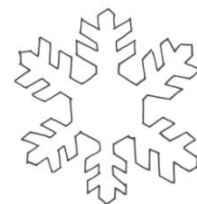
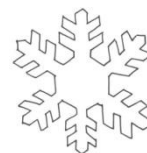

You will travel over frozen lakes, zip across vast fields and manoeuvre through fabulous forests. At the end of each day, you will get to relax, dine and sleep in several quaint and cozy resorts along the way.**

## Here's your itinerary :

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### Day 1 – Departure from St-Adele to Duhamel



Meet at headquarters early in the morning to take possession of your snowmobile and gear. Your personal guide will explain everything necessary for the safe operation of your power machine before departing on your ride through numerous federally operated trails. Your journey will take you through the mountains of the Laurentian and Ottawa regions where you will end your day in Duhamel and where you will be lodged at the Chalet, Couleurs de France. ### Day 2 – From Duhamel to Maniwaki



Start your day with a healthy breakfast before departing west by snowmobile, across the Papineau-Labelle reserve, where we just spot migrating herds of wild deer. Your journey will lead you to Maniwaki which was founded in 1851 and whose development was due to the joint building efforts between the Irish, French and Algonquin Indians. The Desert River Reserve (or in Algonquin: the Kitigan Zibi Reserve) is located just south of Maniwaki. In the evening enjoy the hospitality and dining at the Auberge du Draveur. ### Day 3 – From Maniwaki to Notawissi

Start off your day with a solid breakfast as you will need every ounce of energy for this adventure packed day! You will be crossing through the Baskatong reserve with its immense lake measuring 320 square kms and historically used as a logging route. Your eyes will marvel at the wonderous Windigo frozen waterfalls. In Notawissi, you will be welcomed by the Notawissi Outfitter Club who offer you cozy cottages, a relaxing restaurant and a bar. You can discover their fabulous fondues or enjoy sampling wild meats such as bison, wild boar or caribou. [www.notawissi.com](http://www.notawissi.com)



### Day 4 – From Notawissi to ...

Two choices are available for the last evening of your adventure:

Heading to Saint-Michel-des-Saints to the Pignon Rouge Outfitter : a superb location in the woods on the edge of Lake Mica. You can choose to stay in a room in the resort or enjoy the privacy of a lovely rustic cottage, some of which can accommodate up to 12 people! ### Day 5 – Return trip to St-Hippolyte

Pierrot, your host, will explain all the ins and outs of making maple syrup from the water in the trees to the syrup on your plate!

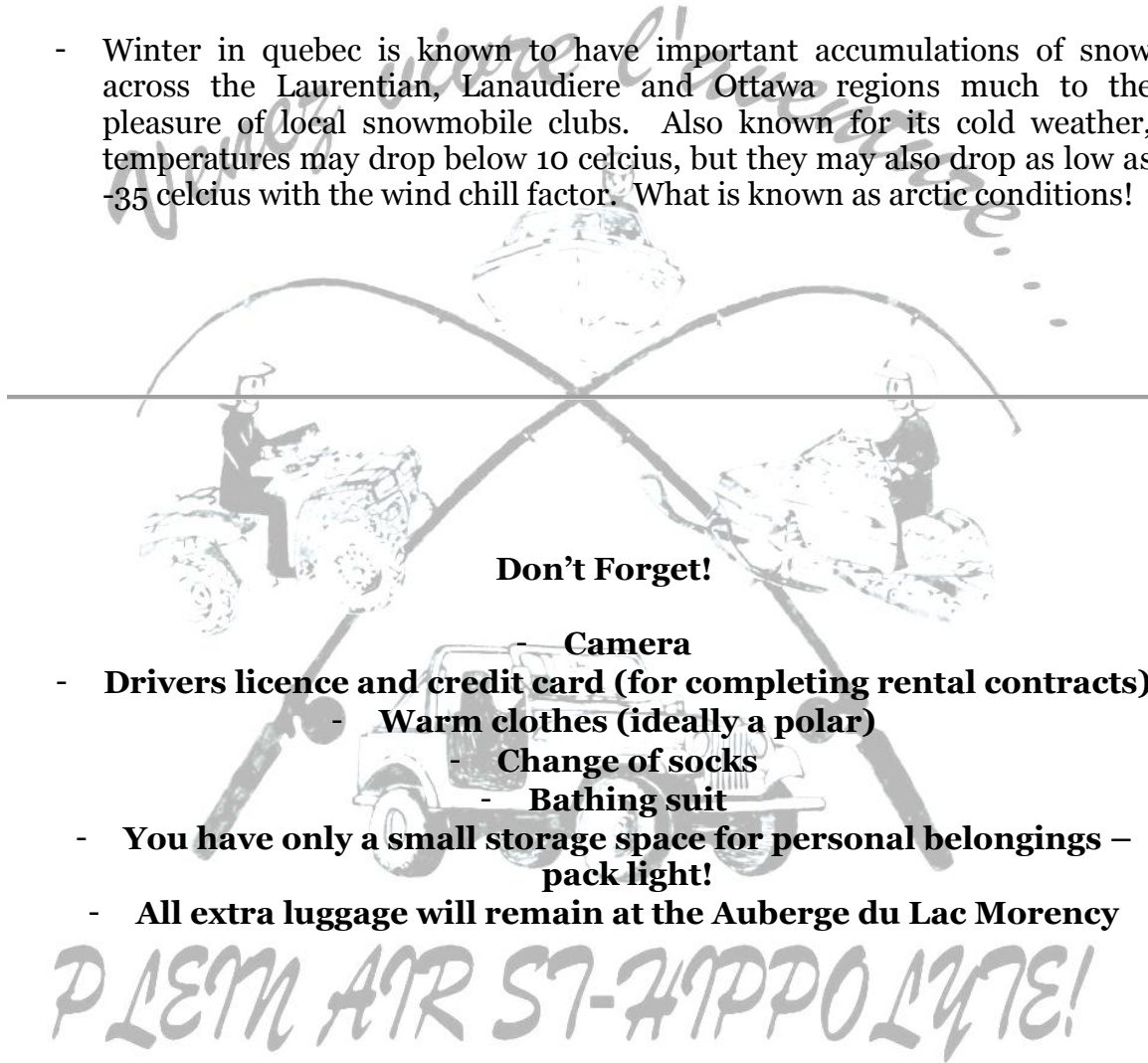


### **Practical Information:**

- Quebec has over 33,500 kms of snowmobile trails (groomed and marked) operated by more than a hundred snowmobile clubs.

### **Weather conditions:**

- Winter in Quebec is known to have important accumulations of snow across the Laurentian, Lanaudiere and Ottawa regions much to the pleasure of local snowmobile clubs. Also known for its cold weather, temperatures may drop below 10 celcius, but they may also drop as low as -35 celcius with the wind chill factor. What is known as arctic conditions!

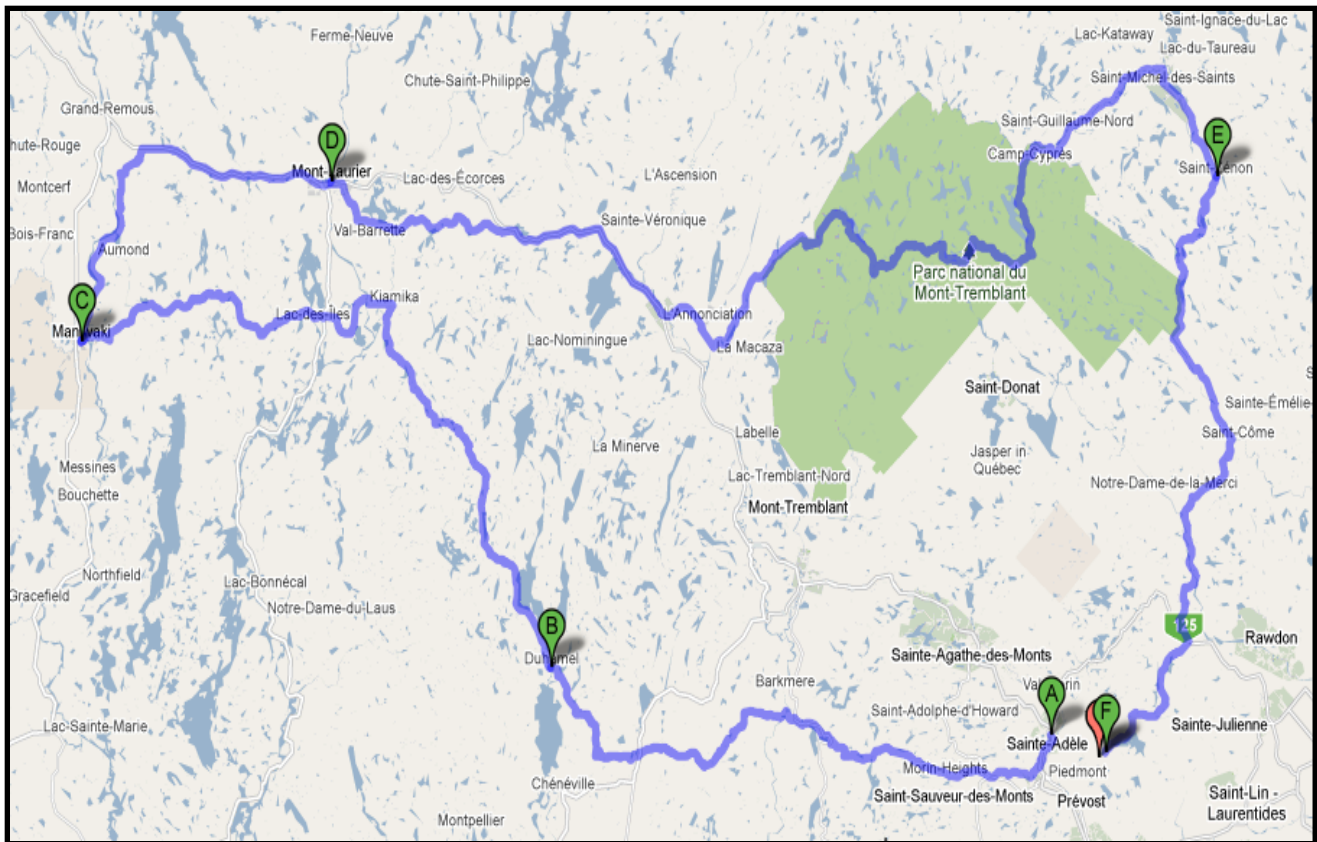
