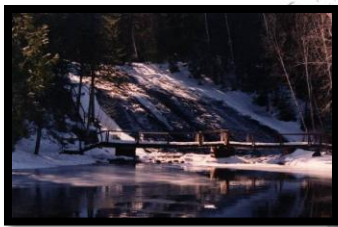
Here is your itinerary:

Day 1 – Snowmobile from St-Hippolyte to Saint-Michel-des-Saints

After enjoying a hearty breakfast, we will be heading out towards the Taureau Reserve, an in-land sea measuring more than a 100 kms long and surrounded by virgin forests and landscapes that will totally take your breath away. After travelling 150 kms on this first leg of the raid, we will end the day at the Mokocan Pignon Rouge Outfitter for dinner and a well earned rest in the middle of no where! You'll be glad to be there!



Day 2 – Snowmobiling from Saint-Michel-des-Saints to Ferme Neuve



A healthy breakfast and you're heading north on your snowmobile towards Windigo, a small village well known by snowmobile fans. We will travel on trails used by the 'wood-runners' or 'woodsmen' (trappers) during the 1800's as you travel through Mont Tremblant National Park and end your journey at the Windigo Falls Auberge where a good night's rest and a belly warming meal await you!

Day 3 – Snowmobile from Ferme Neuve to Duhamel

After enjoying a gratifying breakfast at the auberge, depart by snowmobile towards Duhamel, situated 150 kms south-west. The virgin forests devoid of any civilization and the immense, white, wide open spaces will leave you breathless!

In the afternoon, you will be awaited at the Auberge and Spa Le Viceroy. Now is definitely the time to take advantage of these amazing nordic baths and an excellent dinner. Day 4 – Snowmobile from Duhamel to Saint-Adele

Make sure you fill up for breakfast as a big day lies ahead! You will be heading towards St-Adele, a great little town in the Upper Laurentians. This leg of your adventure will have you travelling approximately 185 kms which will end at the Auberge and Spa Beaux Rêves for lunch and another well deserved rest and a one hour swedish massage.. is there a better way to end a day?!

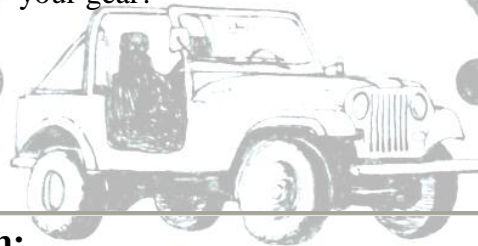


Day 5 – Snowmobile from Saint-Adele to Saint-Hippolyte

Get your motors running with a good breakfast because soon you depart for your last day of snowmobiling. On your return trip you will have the chance to cross through another section of the Mont Tremblant Park, known for being one of the best snowmobile trails in Quebec in terms of quality trails and breathtaking landscapes! Don't forget to take those pictures – your adventure is soon coming to a close!



You will arrive in St-Hippolyte in late afternoon where you will, unfortunately, have to surrender your sled and render your gear!



Practical Information:

- Quebec has over 33,500 kms of snowmobile trails (groomed and marked) operated by more than a hundred snowmobile clubs.

Weather conditions:

- Winter in Quebec is known to have important accumulations of snow across the Laurentian, Lanaudiere and Ottawa regions much to the pleasure of local snowmobile clubs. Also known for its cold weather, temperatures may drop below 10 celcius, but they may also drop as low as -35 celcius with the wind chill factor. What is known as arctic conditions!

Don't Forget!

- Camera
 - Drivers licence and credit card (for completing rental contracts)
 - Warm clothes (ideally a polar)
 - Change of socks
 - Bathing suit
 - You have only a small storage space for personal belongings – pack light!
 - All extra luggage will remain at the Auberge du Lac Morency

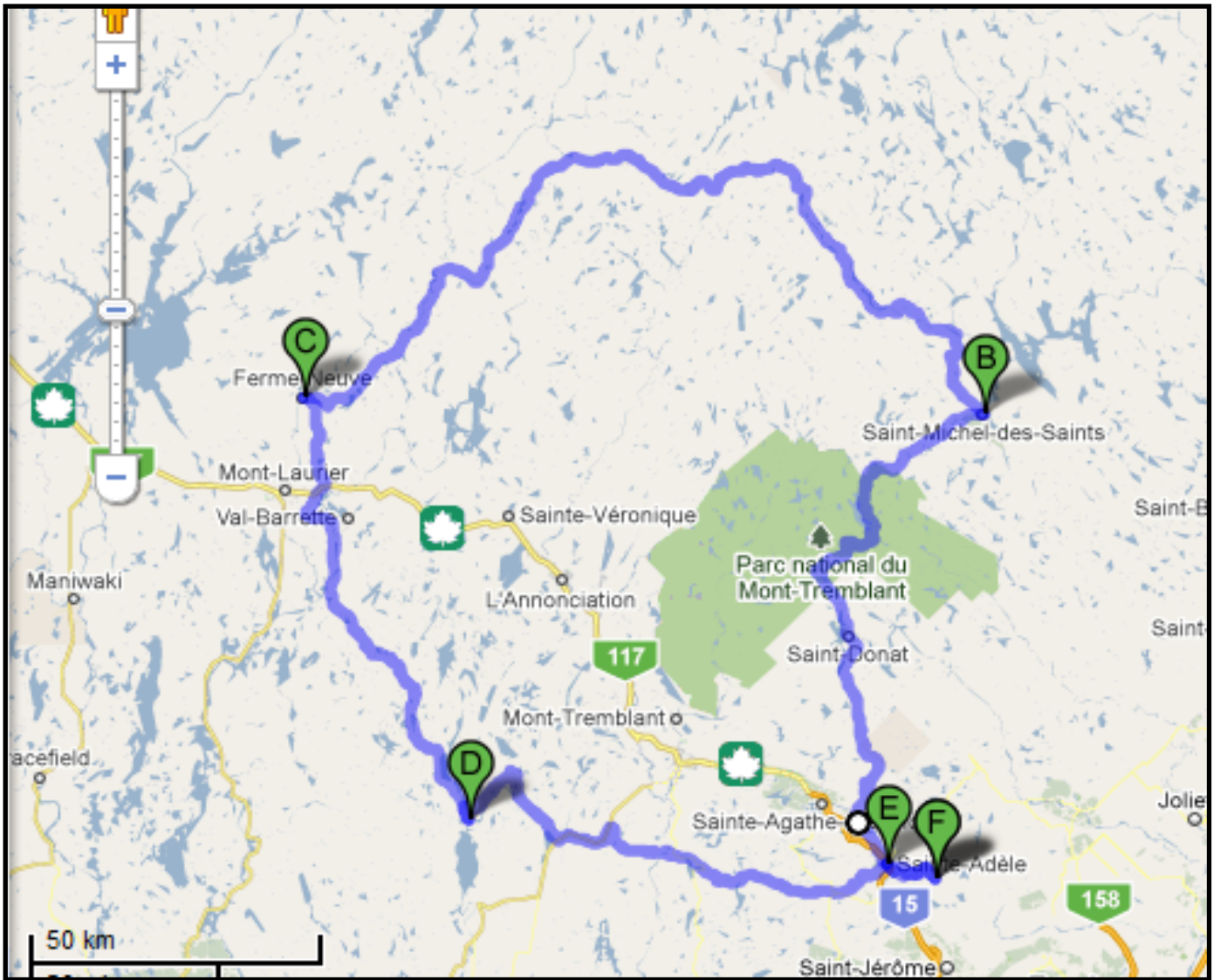
