Here is your itinerary:

Day 1 – Departure from Saint-Hippolyte to St-Charles de Mandeville



Meet at headquarters at 8:30 am to take possession of your snowmobile. Your personal guide will explain everything necessary for the safe operation of your power machine before departing on your ride. Your guide will help you store your baggages in the snowmobile but be warned: space is limited so pack light! Additional items should remain in your room at the Auberge du Lac Morency.

Then, you're off on the great escape! You will have time to familiarize yourself with your sled as you practice on our private trails before heading out on federally operated trails towards Saint-Charles de Mandeville. You will have time to admire the beautiful landscapes and majestic mountains. Your arrival at the Mastigouche Outfitter is schedule for approximately 5:30 p.m. Just in time for dinner!

Day 2 – From St-Charles de Mandeville to Saint-Michel-des-Saints

Day 3 – From Saint-Michel-des-Saints to Saint-Hippolyte



Be prepared for this full day of snowmobiling by starting off with a hearty breakfast! Today, the adventure continues as you head south on the return trip to Saint-Hippolyte. You will pass through the village of St-Come where you will be able to stop and view the giant ice sculptures featured at their winter festival. Do not hesitate to ask your guide to take the time to stop and marvel at these creations and take plenty of photos to remember your quebecois winter wonderland adventure!!!!

Day 4 – Day of Dogsledding

You will enjoy a lovely breakfast lakeside before heading over to headquarters to prepare for this action packed day! Our shuttle will bring you to Mont Gabriel to the dogsledding camp ‘Ski Doux’ for your dogsledding day. You will be transformed into a talented ‘musher’ before the day is done! With the assistance of a professional guide, you will be steering your sled and team of huskies through fabulous forests and to the top of mountains with spectacular views! At the half-way point, enjoy a gratifying lunch in a rustic little inn. After lunch, you can enjoy a tour of the kennel... its hard not to fall in love with at least one of the adorable puppies! At the end of your adventure, your shuttle awaits you to return to Saint-Hippolyte.



Day 5 – Day of Trapping and Ice Fishing



Meet at headquarters for 9:00 a.m.! Of course, enjoy a nice breakfast so you're running on full for this interesting day. Your shuttle will bring you to Martin Le Pecheur where you will learn the joys of ice fishing. You are sure to catch something... and you can enjoy your catch of the day for lunch! You will also get to sample local produce and ingredients such as wild game and enjoy a traditional native indian concoction known as caribou! In ancient times, this native indian concoction known as caribou was a form of domestic alcohol that could be served cold or warm. This quebecois custom has stood the test of time thanks to its rich and satisfying flavours and is mostly enjoyed warm during the cold winter months!

You will spend the rest of the afternoon with Carl the Trapper, a passionate nature lover. On the menu, a visit to a traditional native indian tipi and a presentation of their way of life and why trappers came to Canada. Consciencous of the environment, you will visit the traps in the forest and observe nature in its habitat! You will definitely be doing something out of the ordinary on this insightful day. In order to awaken the artist in you, Carl will guide you through the creation of a dream-catcher, a native indian talisman that is fun and easy to make.

Practical Information:

- Quebec has over 33,500 kms of snowmobile trails (groomed and marked) operated by more than a hundred snowmobile clubs.

Weather conditions:

- Winter in Quebec is known to have important accumulations of snow across the Laurentian, Lanaudiere and Ottawa regions much to the pleasure of local snowmobile clubs. Also known for its cold weather, temperatures may drop below 10 Celsius, but they may also drop as low as -35 celcius with the wind chill factor. What is known as arctic conditions!


Don't Forget!

 - All extra luggage will remain at the Auberge du Lac Morency

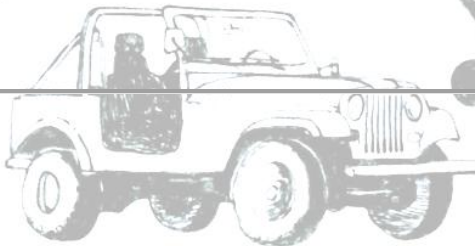

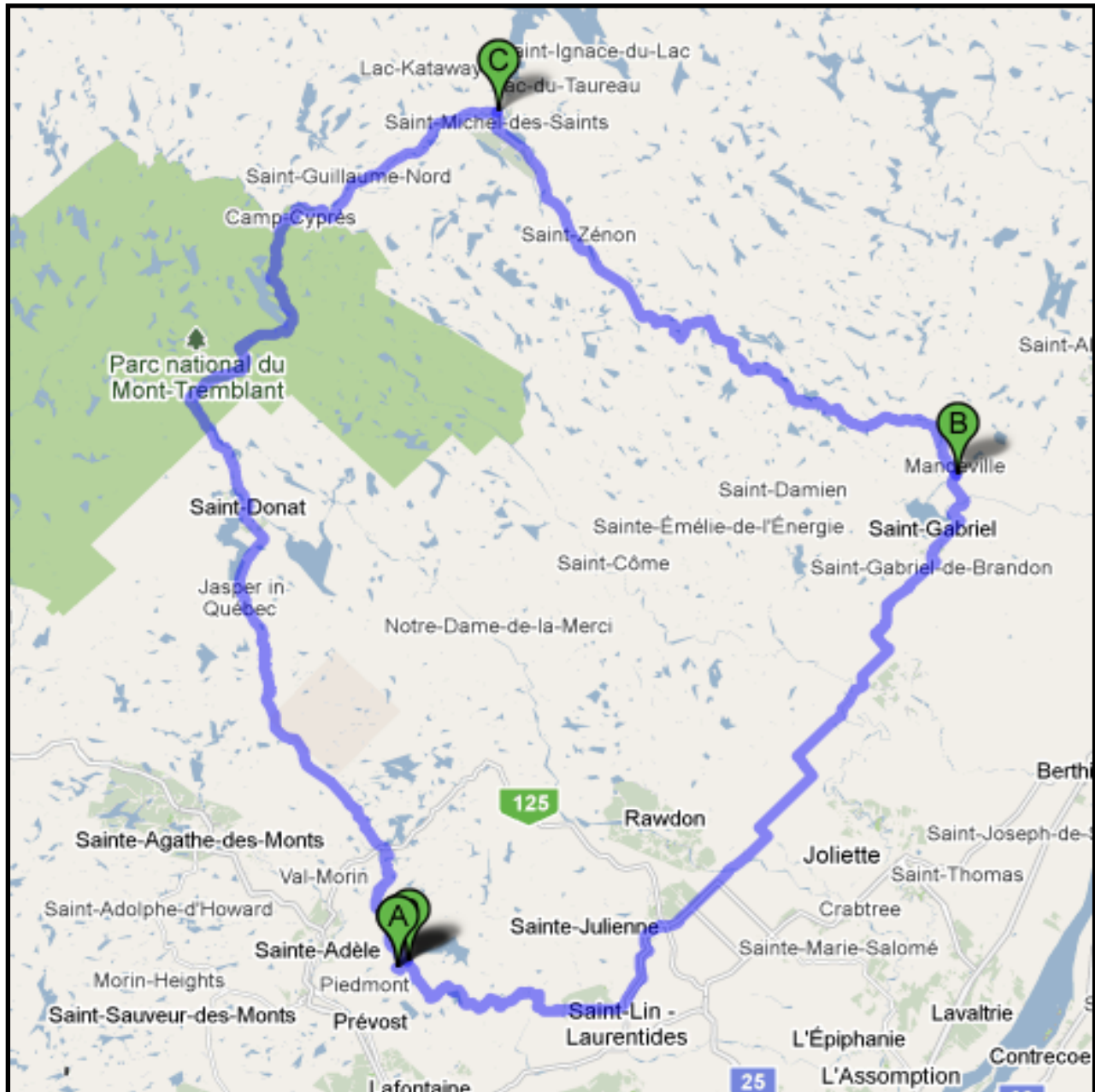
